

National Socialism in Germany

30.01.1933	Hitler takes power
20.03.1933	First concentration camp is built in Dachau
April 1933	Arian paragraphs: -Civil servants must be of Arian heritage -Jewish civil servants in public departments such as universities, schools, judicial departments etc. are given leave.
9.7.1934	Himmler takes command over the concentration camps
1935	Makes laws to protect the German blood and honour: To marry a Jew is against the law. From this point on Jews will be handled differently in our society
July 1937	Concentration camp in Buchenwald is built
09.11.1938	Reichspogrom night
27.03.1940	Concentration camp in Auschwitz is built
15.11.1940	There are 350,000 Jews in the ghetto of Warsaw.
24.9.1940	The film „Jud Süß“ is made on command of Goebbels. Clichés and prejudices about Jews are shown and increased
1940	600.000 Jews in the ghetto of Warsaw
1.9.1941	Police command for Jews to wear a star reading „Jew“
1942	A final solution to the „Jew question“ is decided at the Wannsee Conference.
16.03.1942	Jewish homes have to be marked. The first Jews are deported to the concentration camp at Auschwitz.
1.4.1941	There are still 51,000 Jews living in Germany
27.1.1945	Concentration camp prisoners in Auschwitz are freed by the Red Army
28.04.1945	All concentration camp prisoners are freed
07.05.1945	Germany capitulates
1946	The JRSO (Jewish Restitution Successor Organization) is founded
